CITIZENS' CONCERNS:

Norm Gruver commented on the "Members Present" list from the minutes and asked if the list could include who the members represent.

GOALS & OBJECTIVES:

Chief Administrator Robinson reviewed the "Mission Statement" with the committee that they had developed at last month's meeting. He explained that the purpose of the mission statement is for the committee to follow when a specific issue is addressed and there are differing opinions. Mr. Robinson reviewed the "Goals & Objectives" with the committee.

GENERAL PLAN REVISION PROCESS:

Chief Administrator Robinson reviewed the General Plan Revision Preliminary Schedule with the committee. There was discussion on the preparation process for a consultant, the number of meetings for community input, prioritizing individual projects, identifying each community where public meetings would be held on the preliminary schedule and the City of Red Bluff being included in the community input and site visits.

Chief Administrator Robinson said that each member will receive a copy of the Preliminary Schedule that will show sub-topics, categories and a time line developed for the committee to consider at the next meeting May 9, 2002.

Planning Director George Robson said that he would send each member a list of the communities in the county for their review and to see if other communities should be added for the input hearings.

GENERAL PLAN OVERVIEW:

Planning Director George Robson briefly reviewed the seven elements of the General Plan. He then reviewed what each element has to do with the General Plan. Mr. Robson further reviewed optional elements that are included in Tehama County's General Plan. Mr. Robson also reviewed the current Tehama County General Plan.

Chief Administrator Robinson explained to the committee that at next month's meeting they will be discussing more basic components of the plan elements. He further explained that each member will receive a workbook that will include each of the plan elements for the purpose of adding comments.

Chief Administrator Robinson explained that the committee will have a letterhead that will include each member and who they represent, and the "Mission Statement".

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned 8:40 p.m.
