PRELIMINARY SCHEDULE

Chief Administrator Robinson gave copies of the Revised Mission Statement and Goals & Objectives to the members of the committee. He then gave the members a copy of the Draft Preliminary Schedule and reviewed the time line for the development of the scope of revision, presenting the developed scope of revision to community for feedback, Board of Supervisors adoption on the scope of work, Consultant Contractor selection and development of language for the General Plan, public information seminars, public hearings from each District by the Planning Commission and by the Board of Supervisors, and the final hearing and the adoption by the Board of Supervisors.

COMMUNITY MEETINGS:

There was discussion on where to present the scope of revision in the county and the number of community meetings to be held in a four month period (approximately 25 meetings). Chief Administrator Robinson asked the committee to review the list of communities that were sent to them and see if other communities should be added for the input hearings.

Planning Director Robson reviewed the Resources Group of the General Plan.

The members of the committee discussed goals, objectives and policies in the General Plan, Buffer Zones in Agricultural Lands, classification of Agricultural Lands; Grazing/Cropland, conversion of Agricultural Lands to Habitat Lands, Water Districts, contract renewals and General Plan Implementation.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned 8:40 p.m.
